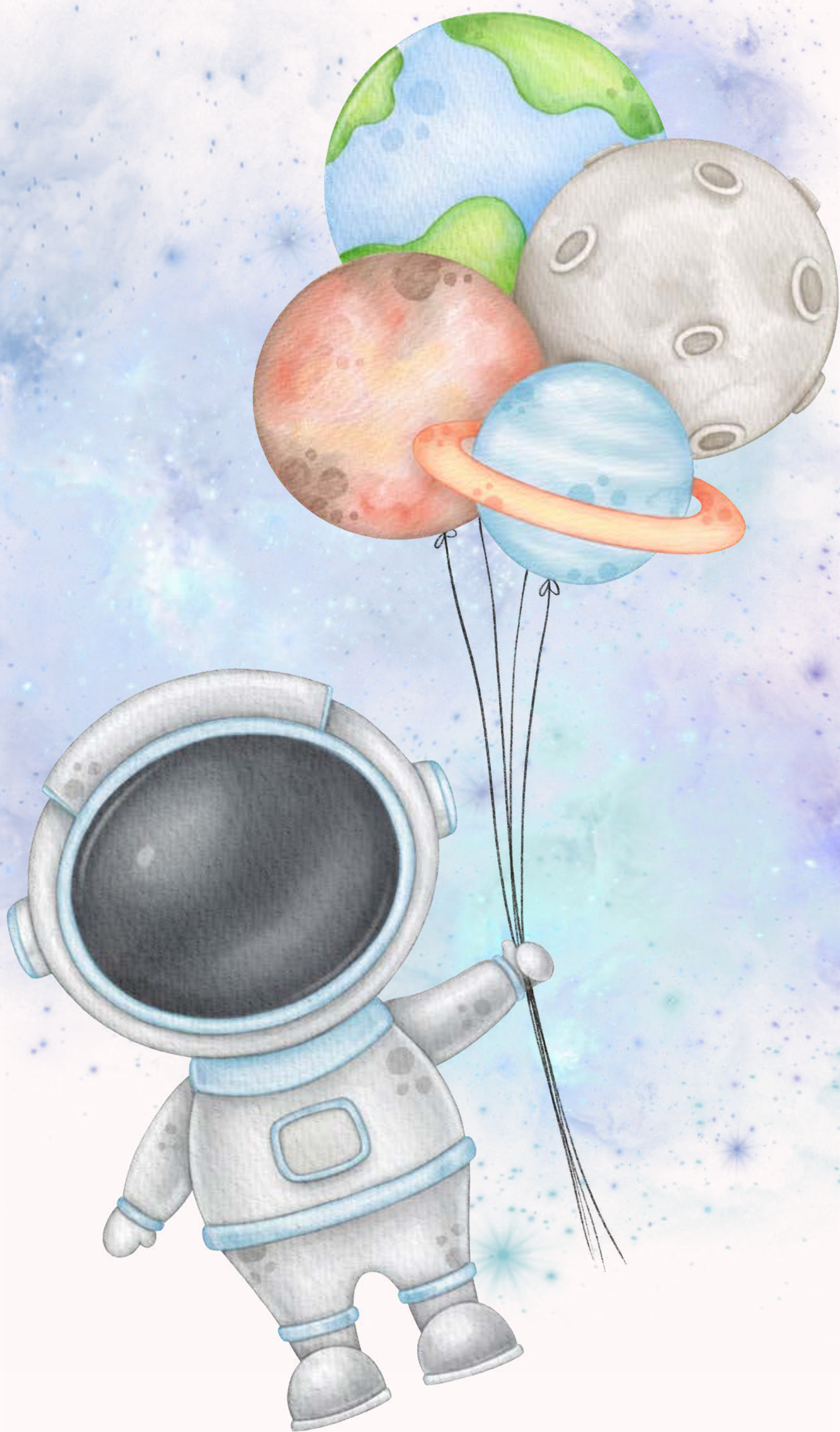

P R E S C H O O L

In preschool, we wholeheartedly adopt the IPC (International Preschool Curriculum), EYFS, and Waldorf curriculum. Our focus is on providing structure and daily routines to promote independence and ready our students for formal education.

During this early stage of learning, children primarily engage in play-based activities. They also learn about routines, develop foundational literacy and math skills, explore the world around them, and enhance their social skills.

Students are encouraged to explore various materials, understand shapes, volume, and quantity, build writing skills, and prepare for reading.

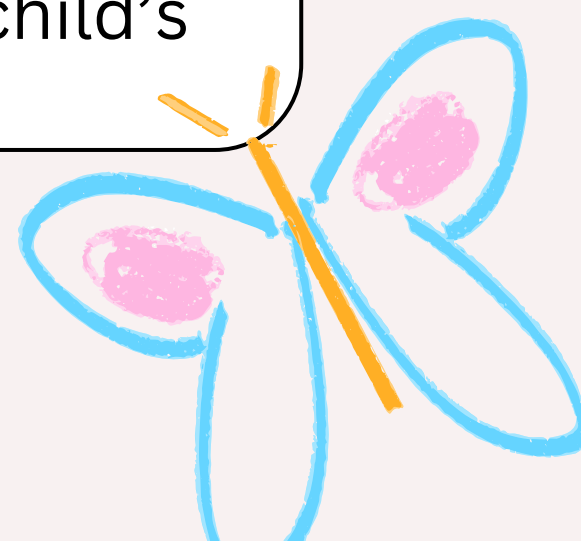

DAILY RHYTHM

A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF A TYPICAL DAY AT PRESCHOOL

Morning time

Our learners enjoy free play, use their imagination, & cultivate friendships. This helps with a smooth transition from home to school. Usually outdoors.



Circle time

At circle time, we gather in a circle either on a mat or chairs. We engage in prayer, sing songs, share a story, dance, and introduce the main learning focus for the day.

Lesson time

The lessons are designed around play and activities. Our learners actively engage in their learning, with educators taking on the role of guides or facilitators.



Lunch time

Learners have their primary lunch during this period, which also doubles as a learning opportunity. They are motivated to pray before meals, arrange the table, and clean up afterward.

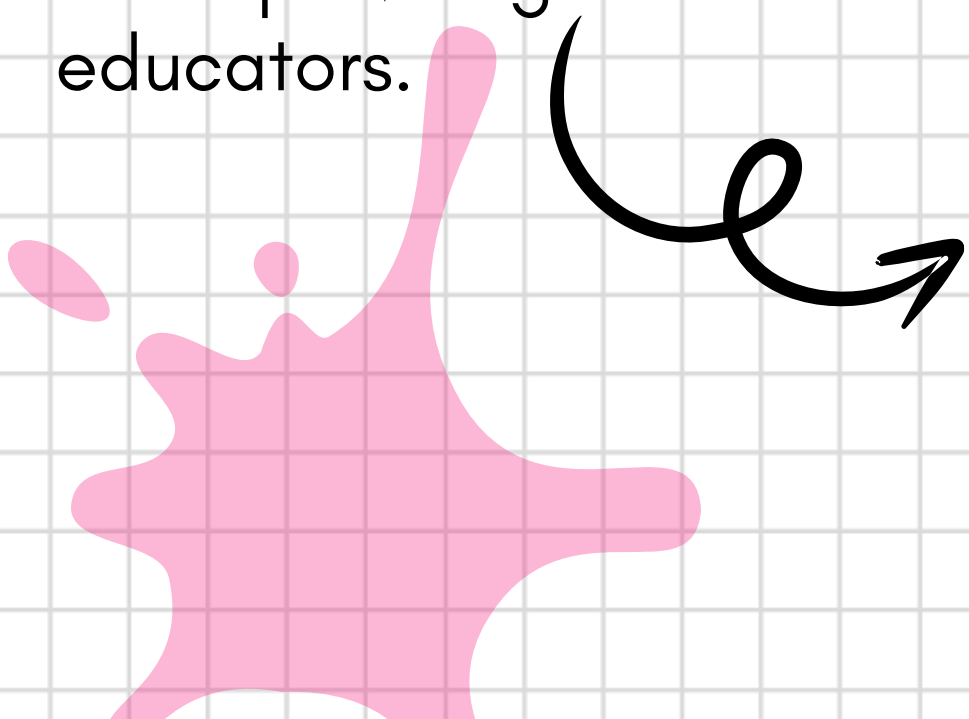


Garden time

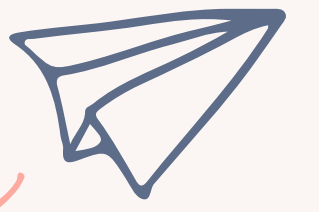
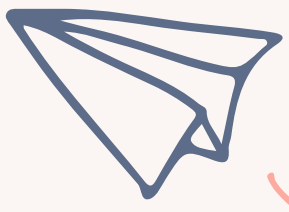
Gardening time is a delightful opportunity for purposeful outdoor play. It involves the use of Montessori learning resources, sports, and connecting with nature.
